I was meditating on **Philippians 4:1** this morning, and I thought of writing a little note of encouragement to brighten your day!

Now, have you ever wondered, if God were to address you right now, how would He call you? Would it be a casual "Ooi!" or a "Hey, you!?" Or maybe those inner voices tell you He'd call you "you good for nothing," or "you are never good enough." Certainly Not!

Listen to what **Philippians 4:1** says. Paul writes to the church, "*Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!*" He calls them "**beloved**"—deeply loved, cherished, and valued.

This is exactly how God sees you. No matter what those inner voices say, He calls you His "**beloved**". Your identity isn't shaped by your weaknesses, but by His endless love and grace.
